- Business and Marketing Program (*Bachelor*)
 - Fall semester: 5th of September 2017 – 16th of December 2017
 - Spring semester: 6th of February 2018 – 2nd of June 2018
 (induction dates may vary depending on campus)
- Management Program (*Programme Grande Ecole*) – Lyon campus only
 - Fall semester: 5th of September 2017 – 21st of January 2018
 - Spring semester: 15th of January 2018 – 27th of May 2018
